Leadership at Christ the King

Christ the King functions under the presbyterian form of church government. The congregation elects elders and deacons to serve as the officers of the church.

Our officers provide spiritual care and tangible help to members and regular attenders in times of need. They come alongside people to assist with needs like encouragement and prayer, budgeting, and financial coaching, helping widows and elderly, financial relief and other ministries of mercy and help.

In March of 2022, our Session voted unanimously to establish two unordained roles that they believe will strengthen the work of the diaconate and session: Deacon Assistant and Elder Advisor. These roles will be held primarily by women who, under the oversight of the Session, will come alongside our deacons and elders to help care for our church and to provide perspective and insight during diaconate and session meetings. We believe that the leadership of our church will be strengthened by more purposefully involving godly women who know our members and who can provide insight into their needs and understand how decisions will impact them.
