The 3 P's of Maximum Impact

- Potency
- Proximity
- Proclamation





POTENCY ['pəʊtnsɪ]

-The power of something to influence

The greatest source of potency will be the Spirit working in and through us.

Luke 10:6, 9
- Bringing the peace
and the power of God

-
- Fruit of the Spirit- Gal 5:22-23
 - Gifts of the Spirit- 1 Cor 12:1-26
 - Led by the Spirit- Gal 5:25



PROXIMITY [prɒk'sɪmɪti]

-Being near in time, space or relationship

Matt 5:13- Salt impacts on contact

Matt 5:14-16- Light illuminates when revealed

Finding the “Person of Peace” who:

- Likes you
- Listens to you
- Serves you



PROXIMITY [prɒk'sɪmɪti]

-Being near in time, space or relationship

Prayer:

“Show me and bring me persons of peace”

Luke 10:5-12

**Seek the POP, respond to hospitality,
spend time with them, minister to them.**



Moving closer through conversation

Superficial →



Meaningful ↓ (What is meaningful for them)

Spiritual ←





PROCLAMATION [prɒklə'meɪʃn]

-A Clear Declaration of something

Share your testimonies

- Share what God is doing in, through and around your life.
- Be ready to share your testimony of coming to faith:

This was my life :

-before I met Jesus...

-when I met Jesus...

-after I met Jesus...



PROCLAMATION [prɒklə'meɪʃn]

Share in the Scriptures

- Those willing to read the bible together with a Christian have a high chance of committing to follow Jesus.
- Important to nurture the relationship with the 'person of peace' before inviting.

A simple invitation: "I've been looking for someone to read the bible with and I was wondering whether you might be interested?"




PROCLAMATION [prɒklə'meɪʃn]

Share the Gospel

- Examples: Four Spiritual Laws/Knowing God Personally; Two Ways to Live; Bridge to Life

Luke 10:9
- Proclaim the kingdom



PROCLAMATION [prɒklə'meɪʃn]

Five Essential Elements of the Gospel:

- God's love and purpose
 - Our rejection of God and the punishment for sin
 - Jesus loving restoration through His death and resurrection
 - God's Kingdom Restoration in you and others (<- Often missed out)
 - A call to respond in repentance, faith and surrender
