Verse to Ponder

"For great is Your love, higher than the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, and let Your glory be over all the earth" (Psalm 108:4-5).

Key Points

1. **God is a faithful God.** God will never stop loving me or break His promises.
2. **God's Holy Spirit comes and lives within us** when we accept Jesus as our Lord and Saviour.
3. The "**Fruit of the Spirit**" is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, **faithfulness** and self-control. I can be faithful to God and other people if I allow His Holy Spirit to lead me.
4. **Faithfulness** is being dependable, trustworthy, and loyal in my relationship with God and with other people.

Family Activity

Take turn to do trust falls with the children. How do you feel when you are the person falling? Why does it feel that way? Is it hard to trust another person to catch you? If so, why? We can trust God to love us and to always be with us.

Family Chat

1. Share about a time when God was faithful to your family?
2. Are there any Bible stories that you can think of about God being faithful?
2. Talk about what being a faithful friend might look like?
