

2018: Journey through the word- Malachi





God calls Ezekiel to prophesy to the dry bones



"O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord. I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live. And I will lay sinews upon you, and will cause flesh to come upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and you shall live, and you shall know that I am the Lord." (37:4).

God invites people into the powerful act of re-creation

God starts to renew and restore through His word



"And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them. (37:7-8).

God's word is so powerful and life-giving

- Jer 23:29- Like a fire that burns and a hammer that breaks
- Heb 4:12- Like a sword that divides the soul and spirit and reveals our hearts
- Gen 1- Bringing order into the world, life into existence
- Isaiah 55:10- Like rain and snow that nourishes and flourishes earth bringing bread to the eater and seed for the sower.

God's word is so powerful and life-giving

- Receiving His word is part of the transforming enlivening work of God in your life.
- Brings eternal life (Jn 5:24).
- The Spirit gives life. His words are spirit and life (Jn 6:63).
- Peter: "Lord to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life..." (Jn 6:68)
