

Christmas Art Festival Guidelines

THEME: Love Came to Town

EXHIBITION DATES:

- City Sunday, 11 December
- Ryde Sunday, 18 December

DUE DATE: Sunday, December 4

 Every Sunday, there will be a table in WIC City and WIC Ryde each to submit 3D / Visual / Print Artwork. You can submit your artwork on <u>any Sunday</u> until December 4.

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Please submit <u>your name</u> and a <u>small explanation</u> of how your work is an interpretation of the theme along with your artwork. *Maximum 200 words*. Detailed guidelines for each form of artwork (either physical / video formats), will be explained in further pages.
 - If submitting physical artwork, provide explanation in printed form: maximum A4 size. Submit together with your work.
 - If submitting video artwork, provide explanation in video form:
 maximum 20 seconds either at the beginning or the end of your video
 - IMPORTANT NOTE: under 18 participants recommended to put their first name and the initial of their last name OR all in initials, for child safety purposes.



- Allowed to work in a team, but would not recommend more than 4-5 people in one team
- You may submit a <u>maximum</u> of 3 artworks. Allowed to be any combination of individual and group submissions. You are allowed to submit only one or two artworks.
 - Examples: 2 individual poems and 1 group dance performance; 1 individual song and 1 group song; etc.
- For Visual and Written Art, please be prepared to print your artwork if need be. We will <u>not</u> print it for you.

		 Notes: Please place your 3D Art & your brief explanation in a <i>box</i> or <i>container</i> when you submit it to reduce risk of damage Allowed to have rectangle bases Allowed to submit only one model (e.g. one building or one person) If you are submitting more than one model, please attach it to a base plate to reduce risk of misplacement Provide explanation in printed / handwritten form (see General Guidelines on page 1)
Visual Art	 Painting Digital Art Collage 	 Size: A4 / A5 Type of paper: your choice (Please be aware that some paper types are not as sturdy as others and may increase risk of damage.) Notes: Digital art must be printed yourself Allowed to laminate to reduce risk of damage Recommended to submit inside a folder Provide explanation in printed / handwritten form (see General Guidelines on page 1)

Length: No more than 2 pages (not including the explanation sheet) Not allowed to print two-sided <i>Minimum</i> font size: 12 Notes: Allowed to be handwritten Allowed to have accompanying illustrations or designs on the same page as the written text Allowed to laminate to reduce risk of damage Recommended to submit inside a folder Provide explanation in printed / handwritten form (see General Guidelines on page 1)
