




PAUL ESTABLISHED ELDERS IN ALL CHURCHES

Also: Titus 1:5; 1 Peter 5:1-2




Titus 1:5-9 (1 Timothy 3:5-7 similar)

⁵ The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you. 6 An elder must be blameless, faithful to his wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient. 7 Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be blameless—not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to drunkenness, not violent, not pursuing dishonest gain. 8 Rather, he must be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined. 9 He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.

1 Peter 5:1-3


- ¹ To the elders among you, I appeal as a fellow elder and a witness of Christ's sufferings who also will share in the glory to be revealed:
- 2 Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, watching over them—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve;
- 3 not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.







CHURCH ELDERS

- > Shepherd/provide spiritual leadership in the church (Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 5:1-3)
- Manage the key aspects of church life(1 Tim 3:5; Titus 1:7; Peter 5:2-4)
- > Teach and protect from false teaching (1 Tim 3:2; 5:17; Eph 4:11; Titus 1:9; Acts 20:31)
- > Visit and pray for sick members (James 5:14)







QUALITIES OF AN ELDER (1 TIM 3 & TITUS 1)

Must be:

- > Above reproach/blameless
- > Gentle & self-controlled
- > Respectable & hospitable
- > Able to lead & discipline
- > Able to teach & refute false doctrine
- > Lover of all that is good

Must Not be

- > A polygamist or adulterer
- > Violent or quick-tempered
- > Overbearing
- > Given to drunkeness
- > A recent convert
- > A lover of money or one who pursues dishonest gain
