

REFLECTIONS ON FREEDOM FROM PAUL'S LETTER TO THE GALATIANS

REFLECTIONS ON FREEDOM FROM PAUL'S LETTER TO THE GALATIANS

As we begin to bring our focus to the theme of Freedom for this year, we want to encourage you to reflect on three passages from Paul's Letter to the Galatians which specifically draw our attention to:

FREEDOM IN CHRIST FREEDOM FROM ... FREEDOM FOR...

We encourage you to reflect on these passages and the questions with your Life Group or a friend who may be interested in further theme.





1. FREEDOM IN CHRIST

READ GALATIANS 2:15-21

In this passage Paul explains that true freedom can only be found by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. To be truly free we have to be in a right relationship with God. To be in a right relationship with God we would have to keep His law perfectly, which no human is able to do. On the cross, Jesus made a way for us to be made right (justified) by taking the punishment for our sins. To put our faith in Jesus work on the cross is the only way to be truly free in this life and the next.

Discussion questions

- 1. What does freedom in Christ mean to you?
- 2. If we are free from the constraints of the law, why does Paul encourage us to not break the law?
- 3. How should our freedom in Christ affect the way we live?
- 4. How else might Jesus give us freedom?



2. FREEDOM FROM...

READ GALATIANS 3:7-14

In this passage, Paul explains that Jesus sets us free from the curse of the law. A curse is recurring unpleasant/harmful event that individuals experience. If we try to come into a true relationship with God (true freedom) by keeping every command, we are cursed both now and into eternity as we are unable to keep every law.

However, when we put our faith in Jesus and His death for us on the cross, we are not only set free from the unpleasant effects of not being able to keep the law, but in His name and by the power of the Holy Spirit we can be set free from the bondage of ongoing sin, oppression and shame.

Discussion questions

- 1. What has been your experience of curses, either yours or another?
- 2. What does the term "redeemed" mean to you in terms of your relationship with Jesus?
- 3. What else does Jesus set us free from?
- 4. What role might the gift of the Holy Spirit play in helping you to stay free in Jesus?



3. FREEDOM FOR...

READ GALATIANS 5:13-26

In the previous two passages we learned that we can only be set free by putting our faith in Jesus' finished work on the cross to come into an eternal relationship with God. Jesus sets us free from the curse of not being able to keep the law as well as the oppression of ongoing sin and shame. In this passage we see that we are set free for a purpose - to share the love of God with others so that they may also have the freedom in Christ that we enjoy. In order to fulfil this purpose, we need to continuously

rely on the Holy Spirit to help us use our lives to serve others so that they are able to receive the good news of freedom in Christ.

Discussion questions

- 1. What warning does Paul give to those who are called to Freedom in Christ?
- 2. What does it look like to walk by the Spirit in everyday life?
- 3. How might using our freedom to walk by the Spirit help others to come to Freedom in Christ?
- 4. What else might we be set free for?
