1 John 5:14-15

¹⁴ And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. ¹⁵ And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

John 14:13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. Aligning Your will with God's will

Luke 22:42 says, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

How do we know what God's will is?


- Biblical truths about God's character
