God's purpose for Moses and Aaron was determined by His <u>plans</u> , not by the response of <u>Pharaoh</u> . God judged Moses and Aaron based on their <u>obedience</u> , not the <u>response</u> of Pharaoh or the Israelites.
God's plan for your life has been in motion long before your current situation.	
Go	d's plan and purpose for your life <u>won't</u> change based on your circumstances.
Your obedience isn't determined by the <u>result</u> .	
God calls every Christian to be <u>faithful</u> and to trust Him with the <u>results</u> .	
Jesus was <u>faithful</u> and it resulted in His arrest, punishment, crucifixion, and glory.	
1.	Jesus was faithful all the way to the point of <u>death</u> .
2.	Jesus demonstrates what it means to live for the glory of God, $\underline{\text{regardless}}$ of the outcome of the moment.
3.	Jesus reveals that God's plan and promises are $\underline{\text{true}}$, even when it seems like they have $\underline{\text{failed}}$. (Death)
4.	Jesus displays the <u>supernatural</u> plan and power of God through His resurrection and ascension.

Faithfulness isn't measured by the <u>results</u>, it's measured by <u>obedience</u>.
