## How can these things be? John 3:1-21

"How can these things be?"

How can someone be changed in way that gains entrance into God's kingdom?

Nicodemus had dedicated his life to giving evidence that he belonged to God's kingdom

It's one thing to ask "what did that <u>man</u> change?" But, it is altogether different question to ask "what, or <u>who</u>, changed that man?"

God saves because He loves.

God saves those who have already been condemned.

God saves those who have things to hide.

God saves and transforms the lives of sinners by His own power

Can someone look at your life and wonder, "How can these things be?"

Would you like to receive the <u>love</u> of God and be saved from the <u>condemnation</u> of your sin?

Romans 10:9–10 (ESV) says, "because if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."

The rest of your life gives evidence, and tells the testimony, of what God has done to you.
