**God is infinite in holiness and all other perfections.**

**God is all powerful and all knowing; and His perfect knowledge extends to all things, past, present, and future, including the future decisions of His free creatures.**

1. God is Omnipotent

This means that God is all powerful.

In His omnipotence, there are things that He cannot do. For instance:

- God cannot lie
- God cannot perform an immoral action

2. God is Omniscient

This means that God is all-knowing,

God knows everything that has happened

God knows everything that is happening

God knows everything that will happen.

God's knowledge does not hinder the will of his creation.

**To Him we owe the highest love, reverence, and obedience.**

**The eternal triune God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.**

The doctrine of the Trinity does not divide God into three parts.

- How is God one? He is one in essence.
- How is God three? He is three in Person.
