How you hear is of vital importance to your salvation, your spiritual growth, and the multiplication of God's kingdom in the hearts of men.

The emphasis of this parable is actually on the soil.

Ultimately the glory of God in your life and in the world hangs on the hearing of the Word, therefore "Take care how you hear."

- 4. Listen to apply everything to their own heart and life.
- 5. Listen prayerfully.
