The Gospel is a <u>treasure</u> worth devoting your whole life to <u>proclaiming</u> and <u>protecting</u>.

Getting the Gospel wrong is eternally disastrous.

The mystery of godliness is the gracious <u>exchange</u> of the <u>righteousness</u> of Jesus Christ for the <u>sinfulness</u> of humanity through His cross, burial, and resurrection.

Jesus + Anything = False Teaching

Anything - <u>Jesus</u> = <u>False</u> Teaching

Getting the Gospel <u>right</u> is an eternal <u>blessing</u>.

The deposit, or treasure of the Gospel, demands that you make your <u>whole life</u> about Jesus.

The deposit, or treasure of the Gospel, demands that the <u>teaching</u> of the <u>church</u> should be all about Jesus.

The deposit, or treasure of the Gospel, demands that we reject and avoid all attempts to <u>distort</u> or teach something <u>different</u> than the <u>Biblical</u> message of Jesus Christ.

Unlike the idea that you <u>bury</u> treasure to protect it, the church has been called to proclaim the Gospel as a means of <u>protection</u>.

The deposit, or treasure of the Gospel, <u>creates</u> a <u>family</u> that we belong to.
