To fully understand the Love and Salvation of God, we have to understand our sinful state and need for a savior.

Genesis 3:1-8

Satan's goal was to get Eve to question the word and will of God.

1. Adam was obedient
2. Eve knew what God required

*"Losing sight of the purpose of God can cause us to question the wisdom of God, too."

Satan painted God as a God who saw His creation as a threat rather than a treasure.

"But each person is tempted when he is drawn away and enticed by his own evil desire. Then after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin, and when sin is fully grown, it gives birth to death." – James 1:14-15

2. Knowing the word of God does not protect you from sin, obedience of the word does.
