## Redeemer: Growing, grumbling, and going with God. Exodus 15:22-18:27

Following God requires listening to His Word rather than people.

Following God requires doing what is right in <u>His eyes</u> rather than what is right in the <u>eyes</u> of <u>people</u>.

Your current <u>destination</u> is preparation for what comes next.

The word grumble is the combination of two Hebrew words that mean "growl" and "rebellion."

Where there is a lack of <u>faith</u> there is an <u>abundance</u> of grumbling.

Grumbling is judgment and is born from flesh and fear.

Grumbling is how we demonstrate our distrust of God's plans and His ways.

Grumbling against your <u>circumstances</u> is the same thing as grumbling against <u>God</u>, because God is the author of your circumstances.

God promises daily <u>provision</u> because His plan is for us to be <u>daily</u> disciples.

God tells us to <u>remember</u> what He has done in the past to help us stay faithful in the <u>present</u>.

God's plans require dependence on Him and one another.

The success of God's plan depends on His <u>power</u> and the <u>surrender</u> of His people.

God's redeeming work results in the <u>praise</u> of those who hear the story!

The success of God's kingdom depends on His <u>presence</u> not our <u>plans</u>.

God's kingdom grows through multiplication, not addition.
