Sincere brotherly love for one another is a <u>defining</u> <u>characteristic</u> of those who have been born again.

Christians love <u>one another</u> intentionally, <u>sacrificially</u>, and <u>truthfully</u>.

God's commands are <u>rooted</u> in His saving and <u>transforming</u> work, especially the command to love <u>one another</u>.

God <u>transforms</u> the lives of sinners through faith in Jesus Christ through the <u>preaching</u> of the gospel.

A handful of observations & applications before we go:

- 1. The members of your church are the people you practice the "one another's" with.
- 2. Being with the gathered church less, is bad for your walk with the Lord.
- 3. The goals of the Christian life do not change, regardless of circumstances.
- 4. The <u>contrast</u> between the love in the church and the <u>selfishness</u> of the world is a witness to the <u>goodness</u> and glory of God.
- 5. The greatest display of love the world has ever seen is the death of Jesus Christ for sinners.
