The book of Job presents us with the opportunity to evaluate the genuineness of our faith and love for God.

"Am I going through these circumstances because I have sinned or because God is growing me spiritually?"

What do I do if I am being tested so I will mature in my faith?

"Believing that God is who he says he is and that he will do all that he has promised." - Andy Stanley

So... What do I do if I am being tested so I will mature in my faith?

- 1. Seek God through His Word
- 2. Admit how hard it is to the Lord and the church
- 3. Rest in the promises God has made
- 4. Rejoice in your salvation
- 5. Remember the reason

The testing of the Lord brings forth maturity.

What do I do if I am being disciplined for my sin?

- 1. Remember that God disciplines those He loves.
- 2. Repent and rest in God's forgiveness and grace (Psalm 51)

Steps to true repentance: Psalm 51:1-17

- Acknowledge the specific sin (vs. 1-3)
- Cry out for mercy and forgiveness (vs. 1)
- Trust in the cross of Christ (vs. 7)
- Depend on the Holy Spirit (vs 11)
- Joyfully share (vs. 12-15)
- Pursue obedience (16-17)
- 3. Press on and persevere
