Think Easter morning: First and ultimate "told you so" in history

Baptism is your appeal to God – that you are claiming Jesus' resurrection as your salvation

What you are doing in the baptism moment is proclaiming to those witnessing, is that by this outward action, you have undergone an inward change

This is a plea to those not in Christ

It is a challenge to those already in Christ

It is a declaration that brings Christ glory
