Paul's confidence in prayer is rooted in the knowledge that God is at work in the Ephesians and in the world.

1. Paul prays for them because of what God has done for them through Jesus Christ.
2. Paul prays that they would know God personally and be faithful to God in their personal lives.

God saves everyone who calls upon the name of Jesus, but He also calls each believer to a life meaning and purpose.

3 Things Christians do after they are saved:

1. Grow in your faith by growing in your knowledge of God.
2. Focus on your future riches and inheritance in Christ.
3. Depend daily on the power of God
