Redeemer: God saves us to represent Him to the world around us. Exodus 19-20

God's people exist to <u>represent</u> Him to the rest of the world.

- 1. God redeemed Israel from the Egyptians by His <u>power</u>
- 2. God redeemed Israel from the Egyptians and brought them to Himself
- 3. God's <u>purpose</u> for Israel is that they would represent Him to the rest of the World.
- 4. God's plan for Israel was that they live fully devoted to Him by ordering every <u>sphere</u> of their life around Him.

The 10 commandments are not how we become good enough for God; instead they teach us what it looks like to live fully devoted to the One who has redeemed us.

Representing God to the world around us is more than <u>sharing</u> the message, it's also <u>showing</u> His character.

Jesus is the true treasure sent to represent God to the world.

Jesus perfectly followed the law and showed us what true loving obedience looks like.

Jesus is the <u>true High Priest</u> that represents God to us.

The church is called to live for God in a way that represents God to the rest of the world.

A life of <u>loving</u> <u>obedience</u> is the sacrifice that is acceptable to God.

The transformed life is when every sphere of your life is ordered around God.

The <u>truth</u> of our love for <u>God</u> is seen through the way that we love one another.

Sharing the gospel and making disciples is the act of calling people into a life of <u>loving</u> <u>obedience</u> to Jesus.

Christians exist to represent God to those who don't follow Jesus.
