James 2:8-13

1. All of humanity is cursed with sin because of Adam's disobedience.

Genesis 2:15-17, Genesis 3:1-6

2. Sin results in spiritual and physical death.

Romans 6:23, Genesis 2:15-17, Genesis 3:1-6

3. Sin separates mankind from God.

Isaiah 59:1-2

4. Good actions do not remove the curse and judgment of sin.

**One, seemingly, small sin condemns a man because every sin is against God.**

1. God is holy and just.

1 Samuel 2:2, Deuteronomy 32:4

2. Every sin is ultimately committed against God.

Psalms 51:3-4

3. Because of His holiness and justice God does not overlook any sin.

Acts 17:29-31

The assurance of God's justice and judgement of sin is in Jesus Christ.

**One righteous act by God justifies all who by faith believe in Jesus Christ.**

Romans 3:21-26

1. The crucifixion of Jesus reveals that God is righteous and just.

2. The crucifixion of Jesus reveals God's gracious plan to redeem sinners from the curse.

**Just as sin came into the world through one man, salvation has come to the world through Jesus Christ.**

Romans 5:12-21

1. The gift of God's grace is greater than the sin of Adam.

2. What about the sin that God won't forgive, the unpardonable sin?

Matthew 12:30-32, 1 John 5:16-17

The unpardonable, or unforgivable sin, is the full rejection of Jesus.

3. No person is too bad a sinner to be saved by the grace of God through faith in Jesus Christ.

**It's true that even the smallest sin deserves eternal damnation.**

What then must we do to be saved?

The Bible says to repent of your sin, believe in Jesus and that He was raised from the dead, confess Jesus as Lord by committing to live your whole life for Him.

What do we do with our life after we are saved?

We devote ourselves to knowing and obeying the Bible, loving and serving one another as a church, remembering and praying the gospel, and sharing the gospel and multiplying disciples.
