Psalm 77:11-15 (NASB)

I shall remember the deeds of the LORD; Surely I will remember Your wonders of old. I will meditate on all Your work and muse on Your deeds. Your way, O God, is holy; What god is great like our God? You are the God who works wonders; You have made known Your strength among the peoples. You have by Your power redeemed Your people, The sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.

GRATITUDE STARTS WITH REMEMBERING

Psalm 77:11 (NASB)

I shall remember the deeds of the LORD;
Surely I will remember Your wonders of old.

Psalm 34:1-2 (NASB)

...I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul will make its boast in the LORD;
The humble will hear it and rejoice.

MUSE STARTS WITH REMEMBERING

Psalm 77:12 (NASB)

I will meditate on all Your work and muse on Your deeds.

Luke 8:39 (NASB)

"Return to your house and describe what great things God has done for you." So he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city what great things Jesus had done for him.

HOPE STARTS WITH REMEMBERING

Psalm 77:13,14 (NASB)

Your way, O God, is holy; What god is great like our God? You are the God who works wonders; You have made known Your strength among the peoples.

I Samuel 17:37 (NASB)

And David said, "The LORD who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, He will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." And Saul said to David, "Go, and may the LORD be with you."

Ephesians 3:20-21 (NASB)

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen.

COMMUNION IS ABOUT REMEMBERING

Psalm 77:15 (NASB)

You have by Your power redeemed Your people,
The sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah.

I Corinthians 11:23-26 (NASB)

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.
