# Jesus <u>LOVED</u> everyone, but interacted with people differently.

#### Mark 10:21-22 (NLT)

Looking at the man, Jesus felt genuine love for him. "There is still one thing you haven't done," He told him. "Go and sell all your possessions and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

At this the man's face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions.

## Jesus CARED for the crowds

### Matthew 9:36 (NLT)

When He saw the crowds, He had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

## Jesus TRUSTED the seventy-two

### Luke 10:1-2 (NLT)

The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places He planned to visit. These were His instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask Him to send more workers into His fields.



### Jesus INVESTED in the twelve

#### Mark 3:13-15 (NLT)


Afterward Jesus went up on a mountain and called out the ones He wanted to go with Him. And they came to Him. Then He appointed twelve of them and called them His apostles. They were to accompany Him, and He would send them out to preach, giving them authority to cast out demons.

## Jesus RELIED on the three

#### Mark 14:33-35 (NLT)

He took Peter, James, and John with Him, and He became deeply troubled and distressed. He told them, "My soul is crushed with grief to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with Me." He went on a little farther and fell to the ground. He prayed that, if it were possible, the awful hour awaiting Him might pass Him by.
