TEACHING NOTE

Epicurus, a Greek philosopher, came to these conclusions about the nature of God concerning good and evil:

- If God is not able to prevent evil, then He's not • all-powerful.
- If God is not willing to prevent evil, then He's not all good.
- If God is both willing and able to prevent evil, then ٠ why does evil exist?

Christianity makes sense of, gives meaning to, and offers a solution for the evil and suffering we experience.

Psalm 73:11 (NLT)

"What does God know?" they ask. "Does the Most High even know what's happening?" Look at these wicked people enjoying a life of ease while their riches multiply. Did I keep my heart pure for nothing? Did I keep myself innocent for no reason? I get nothing but trouble all day long; every morning brings me pain.

- If God is loving, why would He allow suffering? ٠
- If love is a choice, suffering is a possibility. •
- If there is no God, who decides there's evil? .
- Why do bad thing happen to good people? •
