TEACHING NOTES

Mark 9:30-31 (NLT)

Leaving that region, they traveled through Galilee. Jesus didn't want anyone to know He was there, for He wanted to spend more time with His disciples and teach them.

We learn FROM those ahead of us.

II Timothy 2:1-2 (NLT)

Timothy, my dear son, be strong through the grace that God gives you in Christ Jesus. You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.

***Spiritual growth starts with humility -
Someone has to speak into our lives.***

Proverbs 18:15 (NLT)

Intelligent people are always ready to learn.
Their ears are open for knowledge.

We learn WITH people beside us.

Colossians 3:16 (NLT)

Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom He gives...

***Growth multiplies through conversation,
not just instruction.***

We grow when we pour INTO others.

II Timothy 2:1-2 (NLT)

Timothy, my dear son, be strong through the grace that God gives you in Christ Jesus. You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others.

***Discipleship matures when we start asking,
"Who am I helping follow Jesus?"***

Hebrews 5:12 (NLT)

You have been believers so long now that you ought to be teaching others. Instead, you need someone to teach you again the basic things about God's word. You are like babies who need milk and cannot eat solid food.

We learn BEST in relational environments.

Acts 2:44-47 (NLT)

And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity - all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.

Discipleship isn't one-directional — it's relational.

We learn FROM people, WITH people,
and by pouring INTO people.
