<u>Mark 12:30 (ESV)</u>

And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

We must first believe before we can trust!

Proverbs 3:5-6 (ESV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths.

HUMBLENESS REQUIRES TRUST

Proverbs 3:7-8 (ESV)

"Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and turn away from evil. It will be healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones."

Proverbs 1:7 (ESV)

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction."

GENEROSITY REQUIRES TRUST

Proverbs 3:9-10 (ESV)

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the firstfruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.

2 Corinthians 9:7 (ESV)

"Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

CORRECTION REQUIRES TRUST

Proverbs 3:11-12 (ESV)

"My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline or be weary of his reproof, for the Lord reproves him whom He loves, as a father the son in whom He delights.

<u>Hebrews 12:7-11 (ESV)</u>

It is for discipline that you have to endure, God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirts and live? For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but He disciplines us for our good, that we may share in His holiness. For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.
