Acts 2:36-41 (NASB)

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ this Jesus whom you crucified." Now when they heard this, they were *pierced to the heart*, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?" Peter said to them, "*Repent*, and *each* of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. "For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself." And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!" So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

WHAT IS YOUR STARTING POINT

Acts 2:37 (NASB)

Now when they heard this, they were <u>pierced to the heart</u>, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, <u>what shall we do</u>?"

<u>Acts 7:54-60 (NKJV)</u>

When they heard these things they were <u>cut to the heart</u>, and they <u>gnashed at him with their teeth</u>. But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God, and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!" Then <u>they cried out with a</u> <u>loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him with one accord</u>; and they <u>cast him out of the city and stoned him</u>. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul. And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." Then he knelt down and cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
