TEACHING NOTES

Genesis 16:1-2 (NLT)

Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had not been able to bear children for him. But she had an Egyptian servant named Hagar. So Sarai said to Abram, "The LORD has prevented me from having children. Go and sleep with my servant. Perhaps I can have children through her." And Abram agreed with Sarai's proposal.

Genesis 16:5-6 (NLT)

Then Sarai said to Abram, "This is all your fault! I put my servant into your arms, but now that she's pregnant she treats me with contempt. The LORD will show who's wrong, you or me!" Abram replied, "Look, she is your servant, so deal with her as you see fit." Then Sarai treated Hagar so harshly that she finally ran away.

Sometimes our brokenness is because of someone else and sometimes it's because of our bad decisions.

Genesis 16:7 (NLT)

The angel of the LORD found Hagar beside a spring of water in the wilderness, along the road to Shur.

Genesis 16:13 (NLT)

Thereafter, Hagar used another name to refer to the LORD, who had spoken to her. She said, "**You are the God who sees me.**" She also said, "Have I truly seen the One who sees me?"

God sees people the world overlooks.

Ezekiel 47:13-14 (ESV)

Thus says the Lord GOD: "This is the boundary by which you shall divide the land for inheritance among the twelve tribes of Israel. Joseph shall have two portions. And you shall divide equally what I swore to give to your fathers. This land shall fall to you as your inheritance."

Ezekiel 48:35b (ESV)

And the name of the city from that time on shall be,
The LORD Is There.

Matthew 1:23 (NIV)

"The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call Him Immanuel" (which means "God with us").

Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV)

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Revelation 21:3-4 (NLT)

I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, "Look, God's home is now among His people! He will live with them, and they will be His people. God Himself will be with them. He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever."
