Matthew 13:44-46 (NASB)

The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, and upon finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it.

The Kingdom:

God's rule and reign - His power, His Presence, His way of life!

MORE THAN MEETS THE EYE

Matthew 13:44 (NASB)

The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found and hid again; and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Matthew 13:10-11 (NIV)

The disciples came to Him and asked, "Why do you speak to the people in parables?" He replied, "Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them."

JOY THAT OUTWEIGHS THE COST

Matthew 13:44 (NASB)

...and from joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

Hebrews 12:2 (NASB)

"Looking only at Jesus, the originator and perfecter of the faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

INCOMPARABLE IN VALUE

Matthew 13:45-46 (NASB)

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, and upon finding ***one pearl of great value***, he went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Philippians 3:8 (NASB)

"More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them mere rubbish, so that I may gain Christ"

DEMANDS OUR ALL

Matthew 13:45-46 (NASB)

Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, and upon finding one pearl of great value, ***he went and sold all that he had and bought it.***

Matthew 16:24-26 (NASB)

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. For what good will it do a person if he gains the whole world, but forfeits his soul? Or what will a person give in exchange for his soul?"
