7 STEPS FROM JONAH 2:1-10

LOOK UP TO GOD

Jonah 2:1 (NIV) From inside the fish Jonah prayed to the LORD his God.

<u>Mark 9:28-29</u> (NIV) After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?" He replied, "This kind can come out *only by prayer*."
