Week 8: How to Enjoy God

I. The continuation of Christ depends upon our enjoyment of the Lord

Acts 13:52 – The disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Acts 8:4,8 – Those therefore who were scattered went throughout the land announcing the word as the gospel. **8** And there was much joy in that city.

II. Life practices in the book of Acts

A. Calling on the name of the Lord

Genesis 4: 26 – And to Seth also a son was born, and he called his name Enosh. At that time men began to call upon the name of Jehovah.

Acts 2:21 – And it shall be that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Lamentations 3:55-56 – I called upon Your name, O Jehovah, from the lowest pit. **56** You have heard my voice, do not hide Your ear at my breathing, at my cry.

B. Praying the Scriptures

Acts 8:35 – And Phillip opened His mouth, and beginning from this Scripture he announced Jesus as the gospel to him.

Jeremiah 15:16 – Your words were found and I ate them, and Your word became to me the gladness and joy of my heart.

C. Designate times of prayer

Acts 10:9 – And on the next day as they were journeying and drawing near to the city, Peter went up on the housetop to pray around the sixth hour.

D. Praying, Singing, and Praising

Acts 16:25 – About midnight, Paul and Silas, while praying, sang hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them.

Ephesians 5:18-19 – And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissoluteness, but be filled in spirit. **19**. Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and psalming with your heart to the Lord.

Hebrews 13:15 – Through Him then let us offer up a sacrifice of praise continually to God, that is, the fruit of lips confessing His name.
