Week 9: One Accord for God's Move

I. One Accord is the "Master Key" of Blessing for God's Move

Acts 2:46-47 – And day by day, continuing steadfastly with one accord in the temple and breaking bread from house to house, they partook of *their* food with exultation and simplicity of heart. Praising God and having grace with all the people. And the Lord added together day by day those who were being saved.

Acts 5:12 – And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders took place among the people; and they were all with one accord in the portico of Solomon.

Romans 15:6 – That with one accord you may with one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Psalm 133:1,3 – Behold, how good and how pleasant it is / For brothers to dwell in unity!
Like the dew of Hermon / That came down upon the mountains of Zion. / For there Jehovah commanded the blessing: / Life forever.

II. Oneness: A Spiritual Reality

John 17:21-23 – That they all may be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that You have sent Me. And the glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, even as We are one; I in them, and You in Me, that they may be perfected into one, that the world may know that You have sent Me and have loved them even as You have loved Me.

III. One Accord: A Needed Christian Experience

Acts 1:14 – These all continued steadfastly with one accord in prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.

One accord - gk. Homothumadon: "Homo," meaning the same and "thumos" meaning mind, will, purpose (soul, heart).

Matthew 18:19 – Again, truly I say to you that if two of you are in harmony on earth concerning any matter for which they ask, it will be done for them from My Father who is in the heavens.

Harmony - gk. Sumphoneo: meaning to be in harmony, or accord and refers to the harmonious sound of musical instruments or voices.
