LEVITICUS 27:30

And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's. It is holy to the Lord.





VII. WHAT IS "TITHING" & HOW DOES IT RELATE TO STEWARDSHIP?

- The word "tithe" comes from a Hebrew word which means tenth.
- Tithing was a practice that was commanded by God in the Old Testament (Lev 27:30)
- Tithing was to serve as a reminder that all we have comes from & belongs to the Lord & we are responsible to Him for our use of it. (Deut 8:11, 17-18)

Beware that you do not forget the Lord your God by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today, lest - when you have eaten and are full, and have built beautiful houses and dwell in them; and when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are

multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied; when your heart is lifted up, and you forget the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water;

who brought water for you out of the flinty rock, who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end - then you say in your heart, "My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth."

And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is to this day.

"Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me!" But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed Me, even this whole nation. Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this," says the Lord of

hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," says the Lord of hosts.

GOD'S 2 PROMISES TO THOSE WHO TITHE:



- He would open the windows of Heaven and provide supernatural provision for them.
- He would **rebuke the devourer** or those unexpected things that tend to eat away at our finances.





But woe to you Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass by justice and the love of God. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.





And many who were rich put in much. Then one poor widow came and threw in two mites, which make a quadrans. So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them,

"Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."




IV. WHAT IS A DEFINITION OF CHRISTIAN STEWARDSHIP?


II CORINTHIANS 9:6-8
