




WAYS TO STIR UP YOUR GIFT IN EVANGELISM

1) COMMUNICATION (SPEAKING, WRITING):


- **One-on-One Conversations**
 - Build trust with friends, coworkers, or neighbors and share your testimony naturally over time.
 - Be ready with thoughtful, grace-filled answers to life questions.
- **Writing**
 - Start a blog, devotional series, or social media page that explores faith topics.
 - Write Christian fiction, articles, or tracts with relatable messages.

2) CREATIVITY (ART, MUSIC, DESIGN):

- **Art & Design**
 - Create artwork with biblical themes and display them in community spaces or online.
 - Design engaging gospel tracts & pamphlets, church branding, or visual social media content.
- **Music**
 - Write or perform songs with a gospel message at local events, open mics, or churches.
 - Use music as a relational bridge in outreach programs.
- **Drama & Storytelling**
 - Use theater or spoken word poetry to share parables or your personal story in a creative way.

3) HOSPITALITY (1 PETER 4:9-10):

- **Open Your Home**
 - Host meals, game nights, or life groups to build relationships and open doors to spiritual conversations.
- **Acts of Kindness**
 - Open your home to seekers or new believers for meals, prayer, or discussion.
- **Support Ministries**
 - Use your organizational or practical skills to support evangelistic events or missions teams behind the scenes.



4) TEACHING (ROMANS 12:7):

- **Apologetics & Philosophy**
 - Study common objections to Christianity and engage in respectful, thoughtful dialogue.
 - Lead discussions on science, ethics, or world religions.
- **Teaching**
 - Equip other believers with tools to share their faith more confidently and clearly.
 - Teach in Children & Youth Ministries where new people may come and learn

5) TECH-SAVVY OR ENTREPRENEURIAL:

- **Digital Evangelism**
 - Create YouTube videos, podcasts, or TikTok content about life, purpose, and faith.
 - Build an app or website that helps answer faith questions or connect seekers to churches.
 - Support the Church digital evangelism work
- **Social Media Ministry**
 - Share your testimony or Christian insights on platforms where your friends or followers already are.

6) EVANGELISM (EPHESIANS 4:11, ACTS 8:5–6):

- **You may have a gift in boldness and clarity in sharing the gospel.**
 - Start gospel conversations in everyday settings.
 - Lead or train others in personal evangelism.
 - Help organize outreach events, missions trips, or street ministry.

7) WISDOM & DISCERNMENT (1 COR. 12:8, 10):

- **Wisdom - An insight into someone's life or a solution to a spiritual problem.**
 - Speak something you could not have known naturally to open someone's heart to God.
 - Answer tough life or faith questions with divine wisdom, drawing people to Jesus.
- **Discernment**
 - Perceiving spiritual realities behind situations or people.
 - Identify spiritual strongholds in someone's life and minister accordingly.
 - Protect evangelistic efforts from deception or spiritual attack.

8) LEADERSHIP & ADMINISTRATION (ROMANS 12:8, 1 COR. 12:28):

- The Spirit's ability to organize and lead others in God's work.
- Lead and mobilize teams for outreach, missions, or church planting.
- Organize evangelistic events

9) MERCY & HELPS (ROMANS 12:8, 1 COR. 12:28):

- Serve marginalized or hurting people, allowing trust to form and the gospel to be shared.
- Connect with immigrants, international students, or any marginalized groups.
- Learn their language or customs as an act of love and bridge-building.

10) SHEPHERDING (EPHESIANS 4:11):

- Help people grow in faith once they've encountered the gospel.
- Follow up with seekers or new believers and disciple them in the truth.
- This is where you can mentor and disciple the new believer so they can grow


