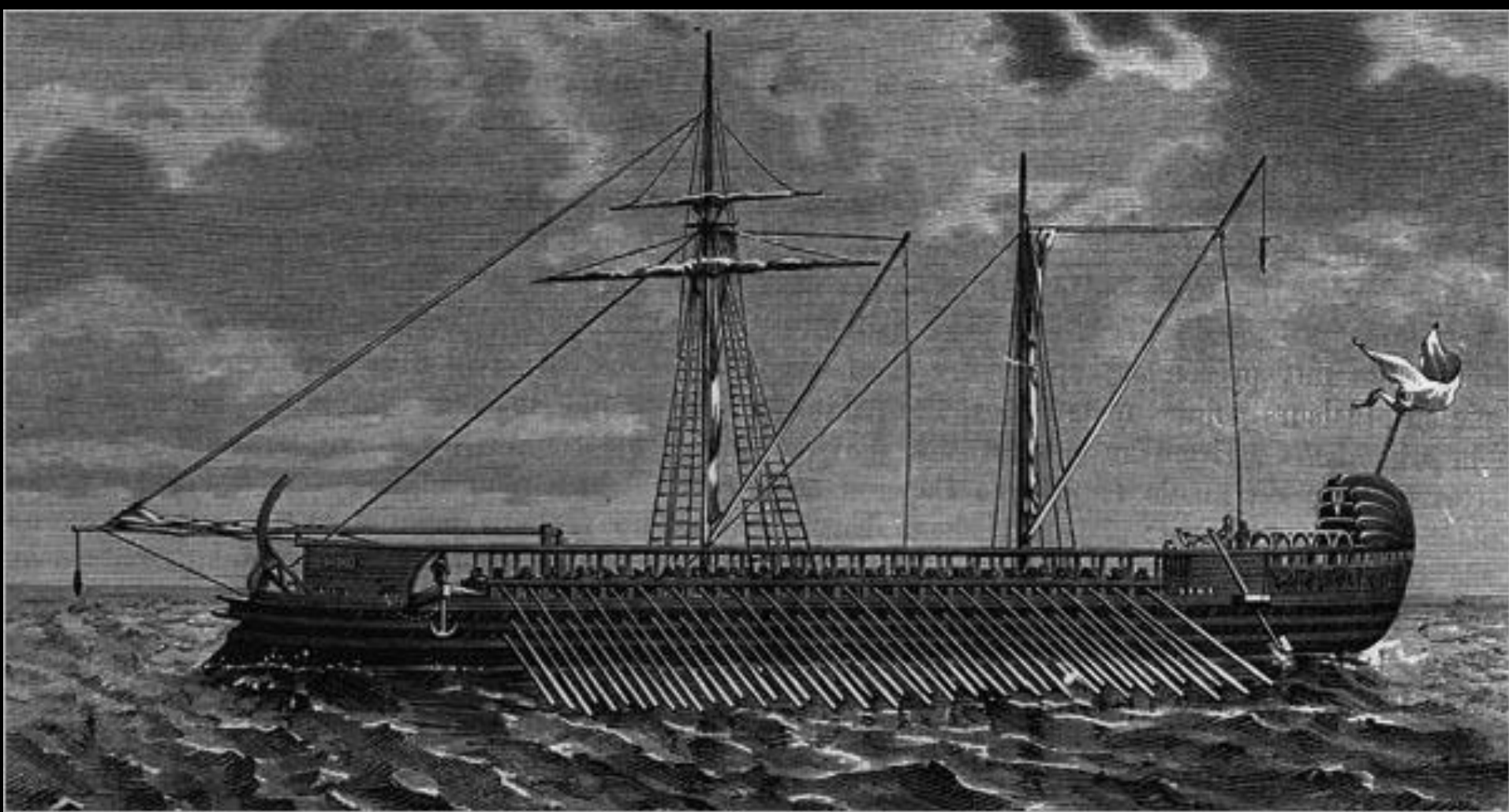

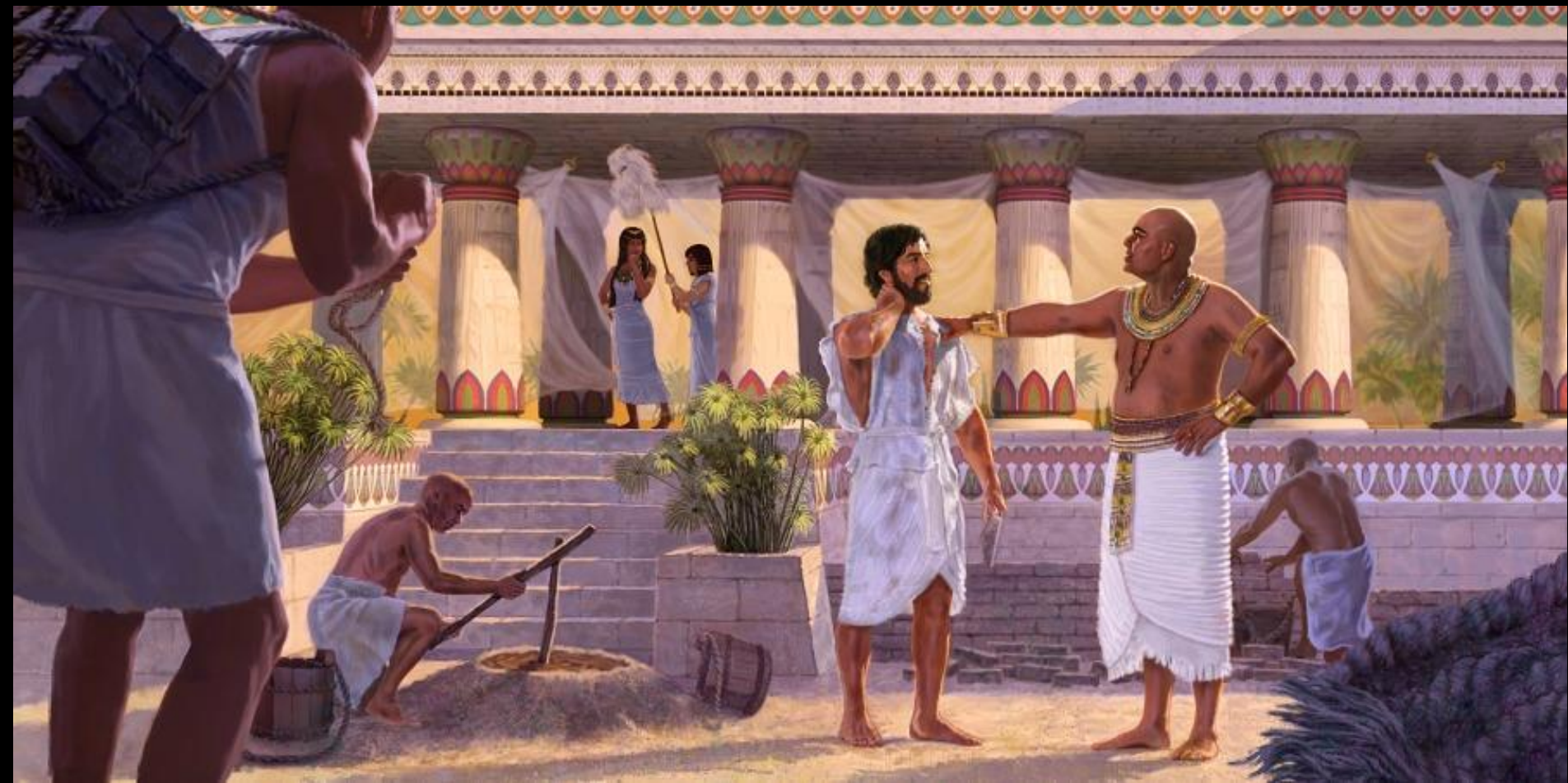
Mark 10:45 (NKJV)

45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”

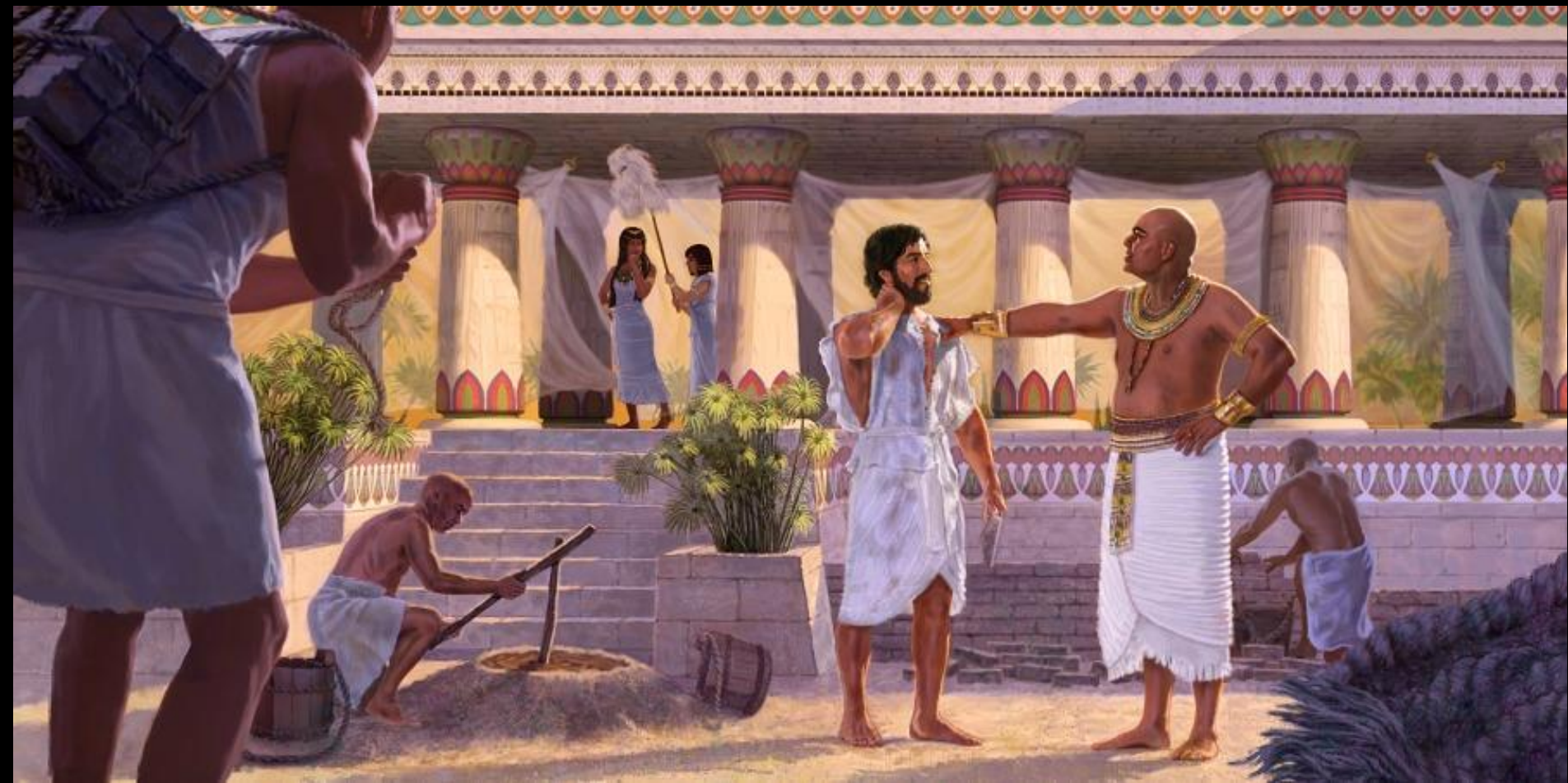
John 13:13–16 (NKJV)

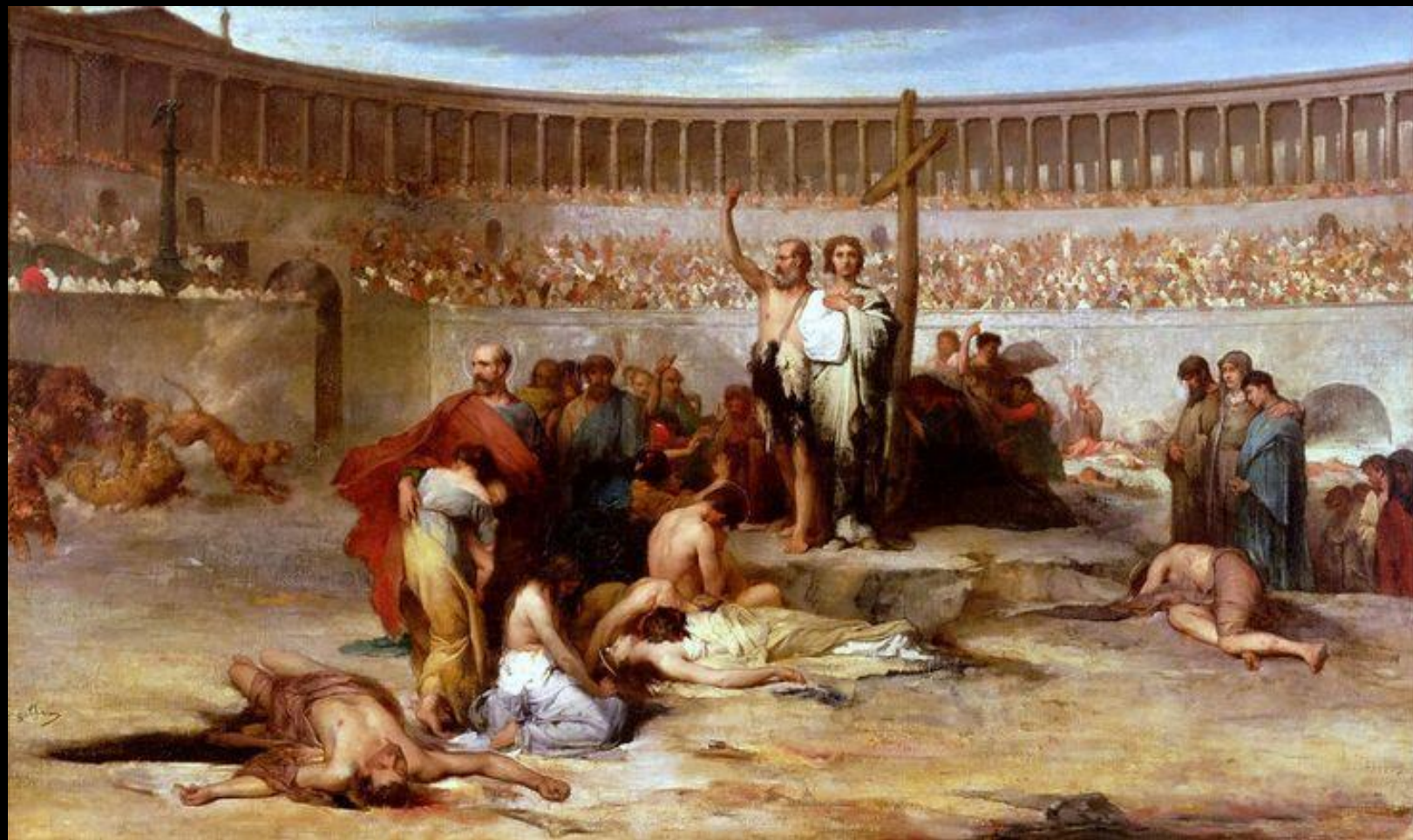




1 Peter 5:5–6 (NKJV)

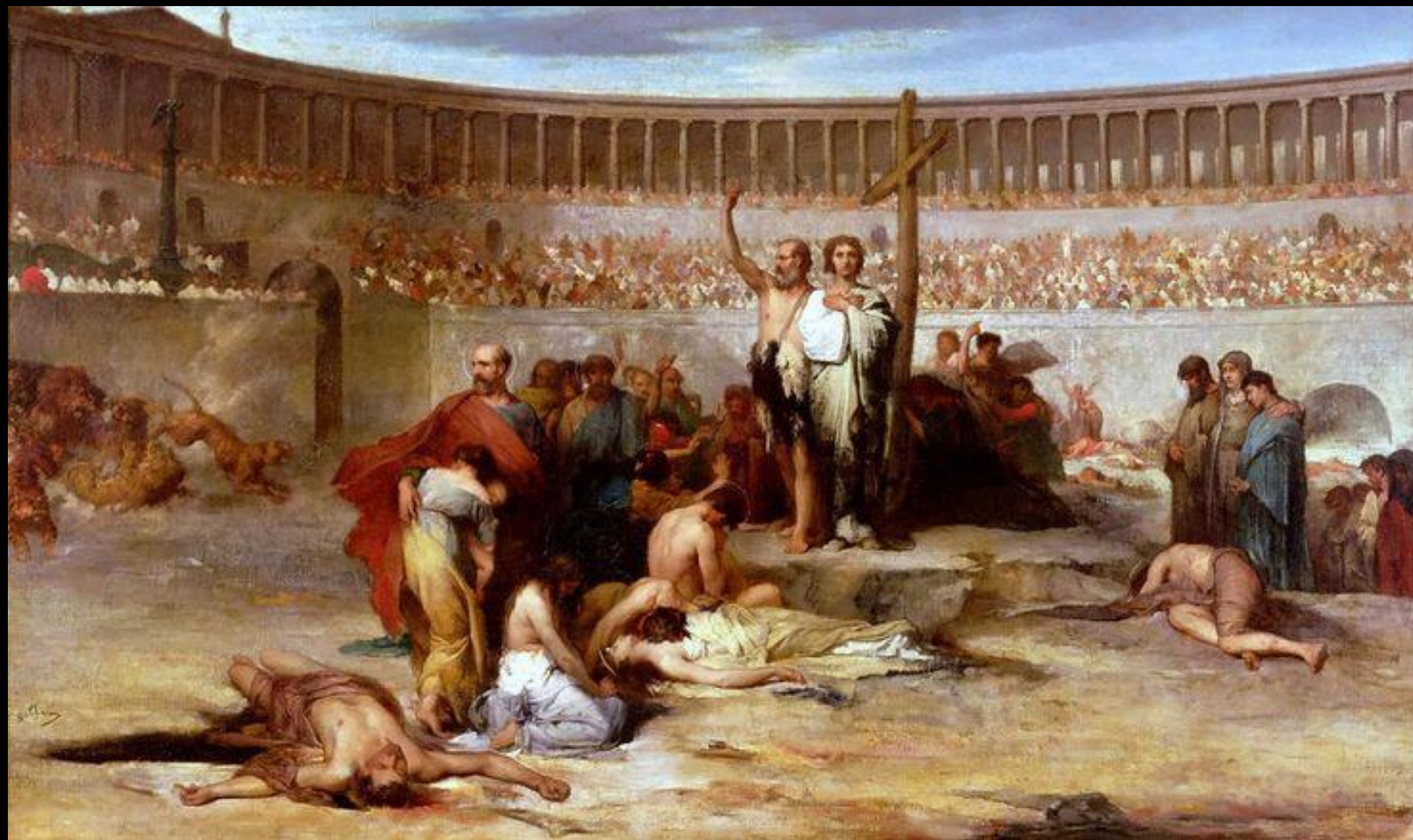
