1 Peter 3:18–22



Manner of Christ's Suffer (1 Peter 3:18)

- Suffered and Died Physically
- Suffered Innocently
- Suffered Vicariously
- Suffered Finally
- Suffered Purposefully – Bring Us to God
- Suffered Victoriously

Philippians 2:9–11 (NKJV)

9 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

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When did Jesus preach to the spirits in prison?

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- Between His Death and Resurrection

Ephesians 4:7–10 (NKJV)

7 But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. 8 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." 9 (Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Acts 2:30–32 (NKJV)

30 Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, 31 he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, **that His soul was not left in Hades**, nor did His flesh see corruption. 32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses.



Luke 23:43 (NKJV)
43 And Jesus said to him, “Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.”





Revelation 20:13-15 (NKJV)

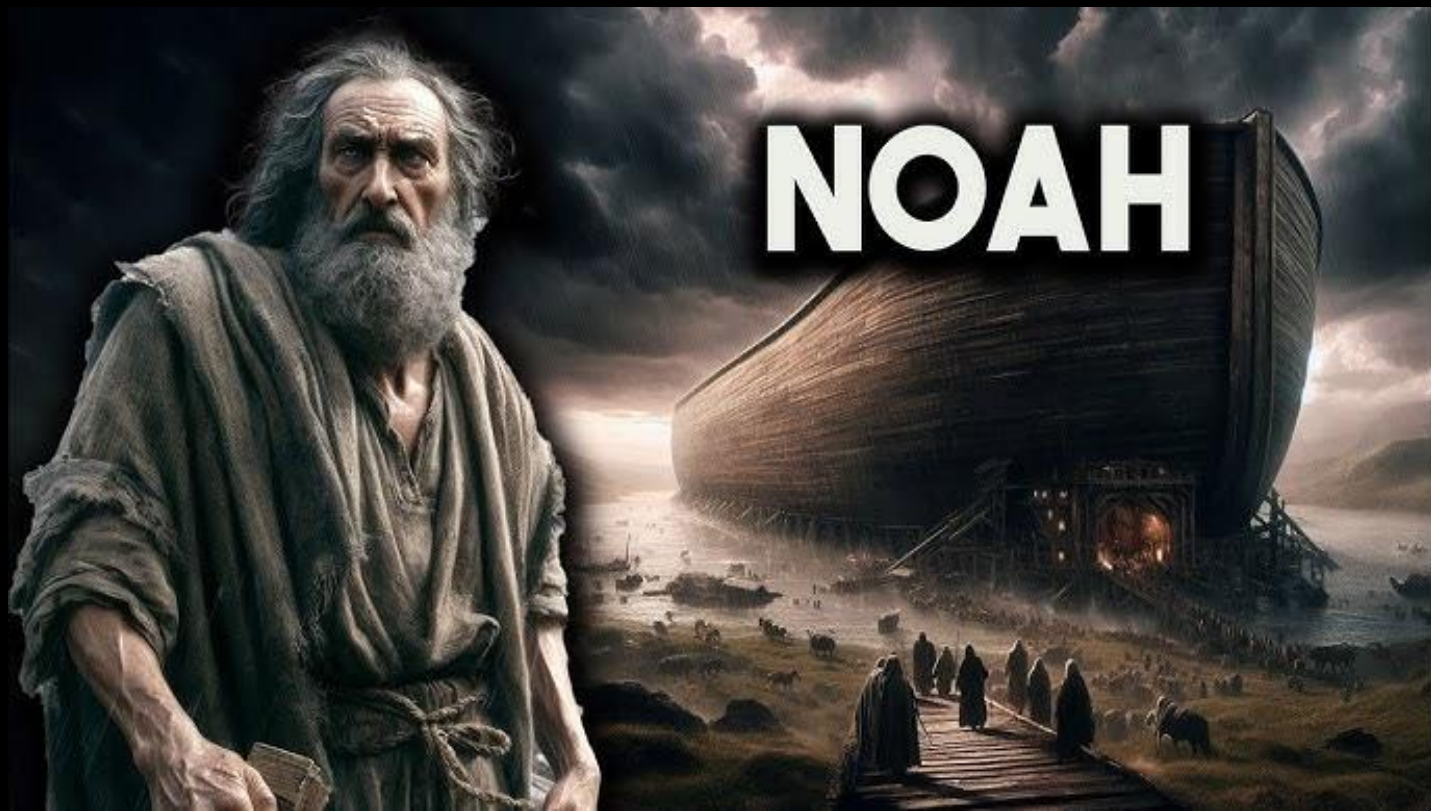
13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. 14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
