Jesus desires 2 things in the John 17:24 text

1. For us to be with him where he is —

direct proximity

For us to see the glory of Jesus

What does the word "glory" represent?

Hebrew kabod -

most basic root means heavy, weighty

Filled with mattering.

2 Corinthians 4:17


"This light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison."

"When Moses entered the tent the pillar of cloud would descend and stand at the entrance of the tent, and the LORD would speak with Moses" ex 33:9

Moses says to God:

"You said I know you by name and you have also

found favor in my sight."

"Therefore, if I have found favor in your sight,
please show me your ways, that I may know you in
order to find favor in your sight."

What does favor mean?


"For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people — is it not in your going with us?"

The favor Moses desires is the presence of God!

There is a system at work here:

"Now therefore, if I have found favor in your sight, please show me now your ways, that I may know you in order to find favor in your sight."

The Cycle of Relationship: God & Moses (v 13)



REMEMBER: favor = presence of God (v 16)

"The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands

"forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and fourth generation."

"If now I have found favor in your sight, O Lord, please let the Lord go in the midst of us for it is a stiff-necked people, and pardon our iniquity and our sin and take us for your inheritance" (34:9)
