#### WAY - TRUTH - LIFE

**John 14:** "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. 2 In My Father's house are many [a]mansions; if *it were* not *so*, [b]I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. 4 And where I go you know, and the way you know."

5 Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"

6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

#### The Father Revealed

7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."

9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own *authority;* but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. 11 Believe Me that I *am* in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

# **The Answered Prayer**

12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father. 13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.

### Introduction

- The Last Supper
  - 1. Jesus shared the Passover with His closest friends
  - 2. The Upper Room Discourse
    - Four major discourses Jesus gave
    - 1. Sermon on the Mount Matthew 5-7
    - 2. The Kingdom Parable Discourse Matthew 13
    - 3. Olivet Discourse Matthew 24; Mark 13; Luke 21
    - 4. The Upper Room Discourse John 13-17
    - The longest and most intimate of the discourses
- Jesus' public ministry was over at this point
  - 1. The nation rejected Him (see John 1:11)
  - 2. Thus, He had nothing more to say to them
  - 3. Behind closed doors, Jesus gave this discourse to His twelve disciples
- Jesus washed the disciple's feet.
  - His example, humbling himself and taking the form of a servant and obedience
  - He who is clean only needs to wash his feet.
  - Tells his disciples to wash each other's feet, and serve one another.

- At the beginning of this passage, the disciples were agitated, troubled, and confused
  - 1. Jesus predicted His death (see John 13:33-35)
  - 2. He predicted His betrayal (see John 13:21-30)
  - 3. He predicted Peter would deny Him (see John 13:36-38)
- **John 14:1** "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. **2** In My Father's house are many [a]mansions; if *it were* not *so*, [b]I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. **3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. **4** And where I go you know, and the way you know."
  - Jesus commanded them to not be troubled
    - He was telling them to stop stressing out
    - This shows that we are in control of our emotions
  - With the command comes the capability to keep it
    - 1. Because of who you know
      - You trust in God; trust in Jesus too
      - Jesus had been trustworthy up to that point
        - When there was no food, He fed the multitude (see Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:34-44; Luke 9:11-17; John 6:1-13)
        - When the storm was going to overturn the boat, He calmed it (see Matthew 8:23-27; 14:22-32; Mark 4:35-41; 6:45-51; Luke 8:22-25; John 6:16-21)
        - When Lazarus died, He raised him from the dead (see John 11:1-45)

# 2. Because of where you'll go (heaven)

- The Bible speaks a lot about heaven (532 times)
- Jesus spoke about heaven relationally
  - "My Father's house"
  - Many rooms, or apartments
- In ancient times, people lived in tents
  - When they added to the family, they added on to the tent
  - The tent would keep growing
- There is room for us in God's house
- In the future
- A new heaven and new earth
  - New Jerusalem will orbit the earth (see Revelation 21:2-27) and be roughly the size of the moon

#### 3. Because of what He'll show

- He is preparing a place for us
  - Heaven will be a personalized place
  - Jesus made this promise 2,000 years ago
  - Imagine what He could do with that amount of time
- He will return
  - The rapture (see 1 Corinthians 15; 1 Thessalonians 4)

- A different time than His first coming
- We have the "blessed hope" of His return (Titus 2:13)
- John 14:4 And where I go you know, and the way you know." 5 Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"
  6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
  - Thomas spoke up stating he did not understand
  - I'm glad Thomas spoke up he opened the door for Jesus to give the gospel in a nutshell (see v. 6)
  - Thomas had a question mark for a brain
  - Jesus was in the process of turning the question mark into an exclamation point
  - · Thomas can't miss this, we can't miss This
  - How can we know the way
    - This is the one question that every religion cannot answer except Christianity
    - Only Christianity answers how do I become reconcile with God.
- There are 2 statements given by Jesus
- · I am the way the truth and the Life
  - The only **way**, the narrow road, the door. **1 Timothy 2:5** For *there is* one God and one Mediator between God and men, *the* Man Christ Jesus, **6** who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,
  - The **truth.** Jesus said in **John 17:17** Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. the word the "truth" became flesh, **John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
    - Jesus is the truth of God. There is no other.
    - Truth: is the life of Jesus
  - The Life. He is the only one that gives life. John 1: was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.
- No one can go to the Father except through Jesus
  - 1. As believers, we are narrow-minded **Matthew 13** "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide *is* the gate and broad *is* the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. **14** [c]Because narrow *is* the gate and [d]difficult *is* the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.
  - 2. Every other belief system that has a way to God besides Jesus is invalid
  - 3. We live in a society where everything is good and inclusive
  - 4. The Gospel is inclusive that everyone is welcome but exclusive that it is the only way. There is no other.
  - 5. That's why the gospels all of them end with the great commission.
  - 6. The only way to the farther is through Jesus.
- · How do I know? there is a subjective and a subjective answer

- 1. Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.
- 2. 1 John 2: 3 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. 4 He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. 5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God [a]is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. 6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

# Philip asked Jesus to show them the Father

- First, we have Thomas who had questions
- Philip was a pragmatist; he had a calculator for a brain
- 7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him." 8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.
  11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.
- · Jesus reveals to them His deity
- He is God.
- He was with the Father in the beginning and will return to the Father after the Cross
- Every tongue will confess and every knee will vow
- Phillips is asking if we can see the Father so we can know the way
  - · Jesus is the way the truth and the Life and no one
- **John 14: 12** "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father. 13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.
  - Jesus said that those who believe in Him will do greater works than He did
    - Not greater in quality, but in quantity
    - Spreading of the gospel
    - Miraculous transformation to salvation
      - After He left, 3,000 people were saved at Pentecost (see Acts 2:1-41)
      - In the first few months, thousands upon thousands of people were transformed
    - More people came to Christ in these first months than in the entire three years of His ministry
  - Whatever you ask in my name
  - **James 4:3** You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.
  - We must look at context salvation and the great commission.
