Sermon Summary

At the name of Jesus, the Name above every Name, every knee shall bow and tongue confess, Jesus is Lord! He is Immanuel, God with us! He is the Light of the World, our Savior and Redeemer. Jesus is the Conerstone, the Good Shepherd and the Teacher. The names of Jesus are descriptive of His nature and His mission. Jesus saves sinners. He builds His church. Jesus sends those He saves to continue His mission. He is the Author and Finisher of our Faith. He is the True Vine. In Him we abide and without Him we can do nothing. The names of Jesus help us see more clearly how to Live Sent!

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Philippians 2:5-11**

Diving Into The Message

1. Who Is

2. Who Was

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from

God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man.
