

DISCOVER YOUR **PURPOSE** // PURSUE YOUR **PASSION**

SCRIPTURE:

Take delight in the LORD, and he will give you your heart's desires. **Psalm 37:4 NLT**

INTRODUCTION:

What IS the purpose of life? What is the purpose of YOUR life? Have you ever wondered if the question of the purpose of life crossed Adam and Eve's minds? What were they thinking the day they ate the "forbidden fruit?" The serpent told Eve that she would be "like God" and she "desired the wisdom it would give her" (Genesis 3). Adam and Eve were tempted into believing that they could determine their purpose independent of God. The temptation and tendency continue today - even in the lives of believers! Rick Warren in the opening chapter of his book *The Purpose Driven Life* writes, "If you want to know why you were placed on this planet, you must begin with God. You were born by his purpose and for his purpose." Discovering God's purpose for your life is the key to pursuing your TRUE passion!

2. I DELIGHT in God as I find JOY in the Community of Believers.

Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, **47** praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

3. I DELIGHT in God as I find JOY in Trials.

We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. **4** And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. **5** And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. **Romans 5:3-5 NLT**
