Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

- Fear and Fracture (The disciples after Jesus' arrest and before His resurrection)
- Looking and Listening (The disciples between Jesus' resurrection and Ascension)
- Waiting and Watching (The disciples between Jesus' Ascension and Pentecost)
- Praise and Proclamation (The disciples after Pentecost and until Jesus' return)
