Life Application Questions

- Of the major world religions, (Jewish, Islam, Hinduism, Christianity, Buddhism, Jainism) which one has a founder that died and came back to life? Jesus appeared to and met with hundreds (500 at one time - 1 Corinthians 15:6) after dying on a cross with hundreds, if not thousands watching, where soldiers who's very lives depended on following orders, were charged with making sure that Jesus was dead.
- 2. How does this information impact your faith? How might it help others?
- 3. What is an eyewitness? Did you know that eyewitness accounts make up the majority of the text of the New Testament? The eyewitnesses to Jesus life, His teaching, His death and His resurrection, led the way after He ascended, by the power of the Holy Spirit working in them.
- 4. As the Lord has worked in your life, what eyewitness testimony can you give as testimony of His love, His grace and His power and authority?
- 5. Did you know that the Bible was written over a period of 1,500 years? Did you know that there are 40 different authors of the 66 books of the Bible including kings, servants, shepherds, poets, statesman, scholars, military generals, tax collectors, doctors and fishermen? Did you know that the Bible has been read by more people in more languages than any other book in history? The entire Bible has been translated into 400 languages and portions of the Bible into more than 2,500 languages. The New Testament was written just a few years after the death of Jesus. The writings of Buddha were penned 500 years after his death. Caesar's "The Gallic Wars," was penned almost 1,000 years after his death. Homer's, "Odyssey," was written 2,200 years after the life of Homer. These are all considered authentic documents. There are close to 30,000 ancient manuscripts and/or fragments of the New Testament today. The New Testament and its eyewitness accounts of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus are reliable but beyond the physical evidence, those who have been saved have the spiritual evidence living in them!
