Summary:

As long as there is breath in the body there is work to be done in the body of Christ. Every member of the church has a role to fulfill in the working of the church. Everyone is encouraged to use their gifting to serve one another in their service to the Lord! Among the ongoing challenges facing church leaders is the alignment and equipping of church members. Targeted information and effective training equips members in what to do and how to do it. Without proper alignment, church members might be doing the right thing but in the wrong place or at the wrong time. Equipping is centered in the fulfillment of the mission of the church as members of all ages are equipped and engaged in the work! Every age group cannot do every ministry related task, but all ages contribute to the effective and efficient working of the church.
