Sermon Summary

At the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow and tongue confess! Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God. He is Lord of All. He is Savior of the World. He is Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Jesus is the Son of God and the Son of Man. He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords. Jesus is the Light of the World. The names of Jesus are descriptive of His nature and His mission. Jesus was sent by God on mission to seek and to save the lost. Jesus sends those He saves to continue His mission. The names of Jesus help those He sends see more clearly their mission to Live Sent!

Diving Into The Message

As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you. John 20:21

Jesus came to To Seek and To Save the lost. Luke 19:10

God has highly exalted Jesus and bestowed on him the name that is above every name so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Philippians 2:9-11**

Jesus is Savior - Redeemer.

You shall know that I, the LORD, am your Savior and your Redeemer. Isaiah 60:16

Then all flesh shall know that I am the LORD your Savior, and your Redeemer. Isaiah 49:26

For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11

You Need a Savior!

He saved them from the hand of the adversary; He redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.

Psalm 106:10

Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

1 Peter 5:8

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. John 10:10

The gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. The gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few. Enter by the narrow gate. Matthew 7:13-14

The woman said to him, "I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things." Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am he." And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.

1 John 4:14

For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works. **Titus 2:11-14**

When the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, **Titus 3:4-5**

Jesus will save you from the guilt of sin, by cleansing you in His own atoning blood.

Jesus will save you from the dominion of sin, by putting in your heart the sanctifying Spirit.

Jesus will save you from the presence of sin, when He takes you out of this world to rest with Him.
