In those days Peter stood up among the brothers (the company of persons was in all about 120) Acts 1:12-15

And they prayed and said, "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two you have chosen to take the place in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. **And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.** Acts 2:38-47

- 1. Ask someone to name the four words from the ONE ACCORD sermon series for the acrostic for P.R.A.Y.
- 2. Ask for volunteers to give a description of each word. Praise. Return. Ask. Yield.
- 3. Which of the four areas of P.R.A.Y. is most natural for you? Which is most challenging?
- 4. Describe your prayer experiences during this series of sermons?
- 5. What have you learned that you will continue to apply in your prayer times?
- 6. Lead your group through a directed time of prayer.
- Praise. Focus on who God is and what He has done.
- Return. Focus on your position with God and any area of disobedience.
- Ask. Focus on what you need from God to accomplish His will in your life.
- Yield. Focus on living in obedience in all areas of your life.
- 7. Ask someone to pray and include the 125 Day weekly prayer request for this week. PRAISE: "God, our Heavenly Father, thank you for 125 years of ministry in and through First Baptist Church Gulfport on the Mississippi Gulf Coast and around the world."
