Sermon Summary

Jesus Is Greater Than . . . Anything or Anyone You Will Face in This World. When doubt, fear, sin or hate come, you have an advocate, Jesus, the Son of God. Jesus, the great high priest, is able to sympathize with your weaknesses. You then, hold fast to your confession of faith and with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that you may receive mercy and find grace to help in your time of need (Hebrews 4:14-15 paraphrased). Jesus, the Son of God, the great high priest, is greater than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4 paraphrased).

Diving Into The Message

Hate

For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.We should not be like Cain, who was of the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous. Do not be surprised, brothers, that the world hates you. We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brothers. Whoever does not love abides in death. By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.
