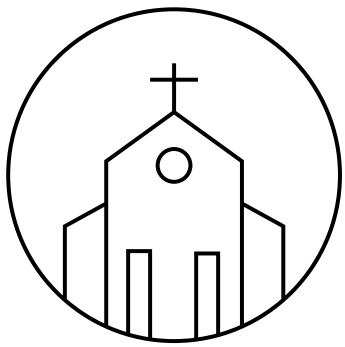

Our Missionary of the Week will be a report from the **Lakeview Mission Trip Team**. Lakeview Church is located in Stansbury Park, Utah and was started on Easter Sunday 2019. A second campus was started on Easter Sunday 2021 in Grantsville, Utah. They have baptized 97 individuals since the church was started. The goal of the church is to help people find the joy and freedom that comes with having a relationship with Jesus. Pastors Phil Wiebe and Jason Unruh would like us to join them in praying that people will join the new prayer groups that are starting, that mentor relationships will be formed as a result, that seasoned Christians will step up and disciple the newly baptized Christians well, and for wisdom for the church leaders as they plan ahead for when the lease on their building terminates in four years.

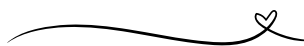
Nursery (birth through Age 2): Children's Center, as well as a parent room in the foyer of the sanctuary, next to the Women's Restroom.

RMBC'S MINISTRIES TO SENIOR CITIZENS

Mennonite Brethren Homes, Inc. organized in 1942 with 5 churches represented. The pictured home was purchased for \$2500 to house 6 people. From 1942-1953 the facility/ministry expanded to 53 residents. In 1966 the former Reedley Hospital was purchased for \$25,100 at the corner of Dinuba & Reed Avenues and developed into what was named Pleasant View Manor. In 1977 visionaries from churches and community encouraged the board to purchase 10 acres to the south at the corner of Herbert & Reed Avenues. Much planning led up to the beginning of extensive construction in August of 1981. Initially 12 Patio Homes were completed and filled so more were added until 66 1- and 2- bedroom Patio Homes were completed. The Residential Care Center housing Assisted Living with 74 beds was dedicated in 1987.

Since 1995 convalescent and memory care facilities have been added along with more Patio Homes. What was called Palm Haven was renamed "Palm Village Retirement Community" and now offers loving and sensitive Christian fellowship and needed care for not only **RMBC** but also for the surrounding community. Palm Village, with a capacity of 300+, represents a **HUGE MISSION** to many from ---or near **RMBC** as well as folks from other areas who seek high quality Christian care.
