



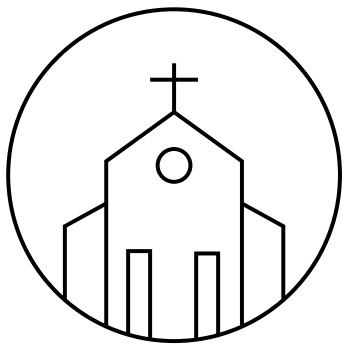

Area #4: God's word talks about the...**pain**...(Genesis 37:29-36)

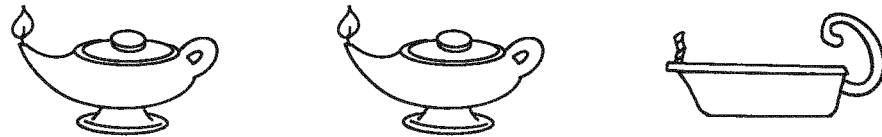
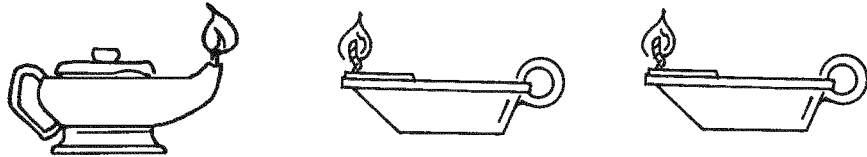
- Joseph must have felt pain in being rejected by his brothers. Name other people that experienced pain in the Bible.

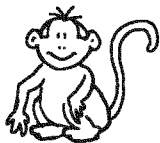
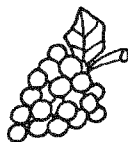
