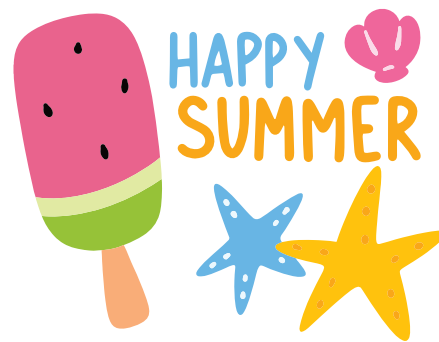

John 21 – Discussion Questions. "Do You Love Me?"

1. Why do you think the disciples went fishing after the resurrection? (vv. 1–3) Were they simply providing for themselves, waiting for Jesus' next instructions, or returning to their old way of life? What does this reveal about them?

2. Why did Jesus allow the disciples to fish all night without catching anything before performing the miracle? (vv. 4–8)

What lessons does this teach about dependence on Christ?

3. Jesus already had fish and bread waiting on the shore (vv. 9–14). Why did He ask the disciples to bring some of the fish they had caught?

What does this teach us about God's provision and our partnership with Him in His work?

4. Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love Me?" (vv. 15–17). Why was this conversation so important? How did these questions restore Peter?

5. Each time Peter affirmed his love, Jesus responded, "Feed My lambs...Shepherd My sheep...Feed My sheep."

How can every Christian "feed" or encourage others spiritually?

6. Jesus told Peter that following Him would lead to suffering and death (v.18–19).

Why doesn't Jesus promise an easy life to those who follow Him?

How should believers respond when obedience becomes costly?

7. Peter immediately asked, "Lord, what about this man?" John (vv. 20–22).

Why are we so prone to compare our lives, ministries, or circumstances with others?

In what areas are you tempted to ask, "What about him?" instead of following Jesus?

8. Jesus answered Peter, "What is that to you? You follow Me."

What distractions most often keep you from focusing on your own walk with Christ?

What does it practically mean to "follow Me" today?

9. John corrects a misunderstanding about Jesus' words (vv. 23–24).

What does this teach us about the importance of accurately understanding and communicating God's Word?

Why is eyewitness testimony significant to our confidence in the Gospel?

10. John closes by saying that if everything Jesus did were written down, "the world itself could not contain the books" (v. 25).

What does this statement tell us about the greatness, majesty, and inexhaustible work of Jesus Christ?

After studying John 21, what truth has most challenged or encouraged you personally?

Closing Challenge

Throughout John 21, Jesus asks one searching question and gives one clear command:

"Do you love Me?"

"Follow Me."

As you leave this study, ask yourself:

If Jesus asked me today, "Do you love Me?" what evidence in my life would answer that question? And what is one step of obedience I need to take this week to follow Him more faithfully?
