






"Christmas in Isaiah: What does God want me to do this Christmas?" December 10, 2023 Isaiah 6 (pg. 571) and Selected Scriptures Pastor Jeff Wheeland

- Read Isaiah 6 in your Sunday School Class.
- Prayer time: Go around your group and get prayer requests. Pray together.
- Ice Breaker #1: Did your family members go to see Santa when you were a kid? When did you realize that Santa wasn't real? What gave it away?

Action Step #3: **Be the Volunteer** (Isaiah 6:8-13)


- Isaiah says, "Here am I. Send me."




